

HOW TO ACCESS THE PSAS

Where can I access broadcast quality materials to share with my local media?

PSA Central: PSA Central is the Ad Council's digital ad delivery platform that provides instant access to all current Ad Council PSAs across all media types, including HD TV. PSA Central allows individuals to download single PSAs or download a bundle of PSAs to use in donated media space or for educational purposes.

What materials can I access?

On PSA Central, the following broadcast materials can be found and/or downloaded:

- TV: Varying length TV spots including :60 and :30 second formats - including broadcast quality HD + SD TV spots
- Online/Mobile Banners: 728x90, 300x600, 300x250, 160x600
- Print & Out Of Home Ads: in various sizes

PSA Central offers:

- Enhanced search functionality, including filtered search to help you quickly and easily find the format and file type you need
- "Shopping cart" feature with options to download PSAs from cart, email PSAs from cart, or save PSAs to your FTP server so you can easily share PSAs with local media

How can I access?

To access and/or download the Save The Food PSAs, please visit the Ad Council's PSA Central website via the link below. You will be brought to the PSA Central website where you will be asked to create an account in order to download high resolution, broadcast quality and print-ready files free of charge.
